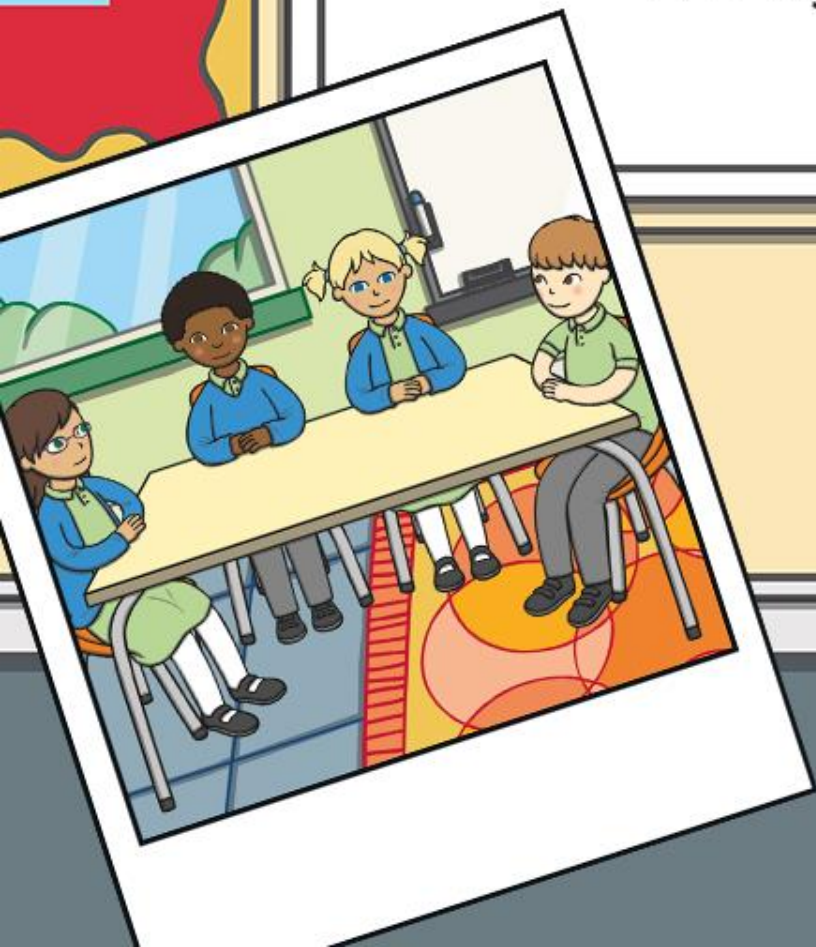


Starting School

When you come into the classroom, you will need to take off your coat and hang it on your peg. Each child in our class has their own peg. You can put your PE bag on your peg too.

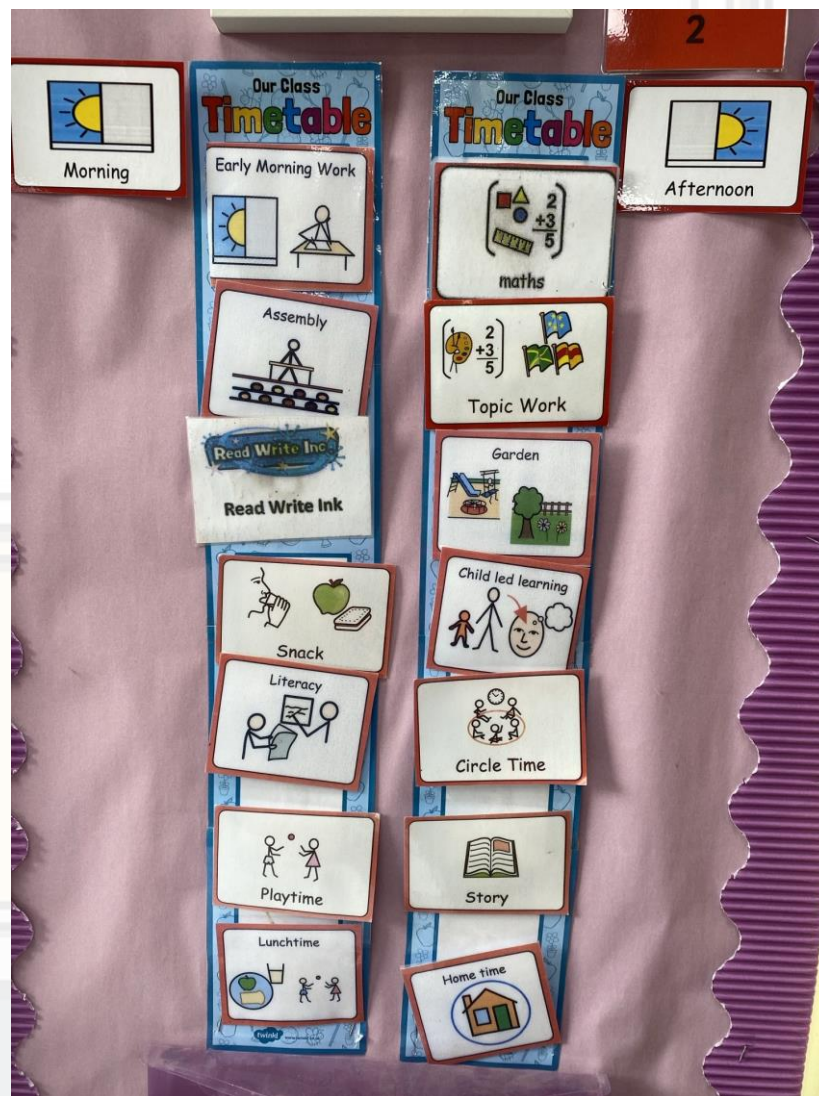

We then all sit on the carpet and start our learning! I will talk to you about the day and show you our class timetable so you can see all the wonderful things we will be doing.

outside?

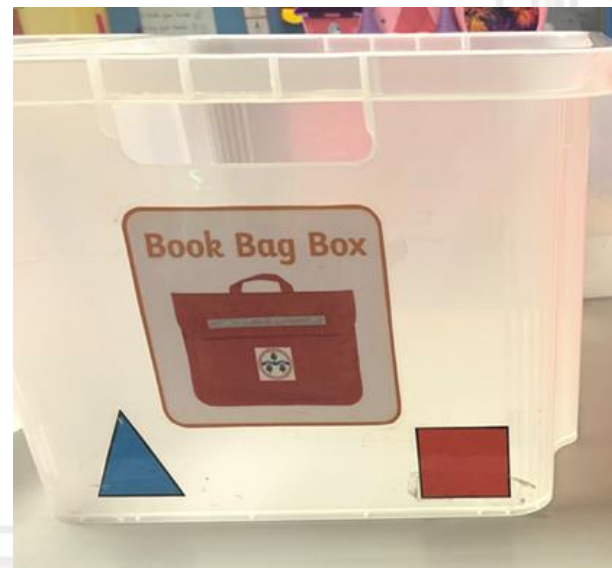
Just before it is time to go home, we sit together on the carpet and talk about all the fun things we did today.
