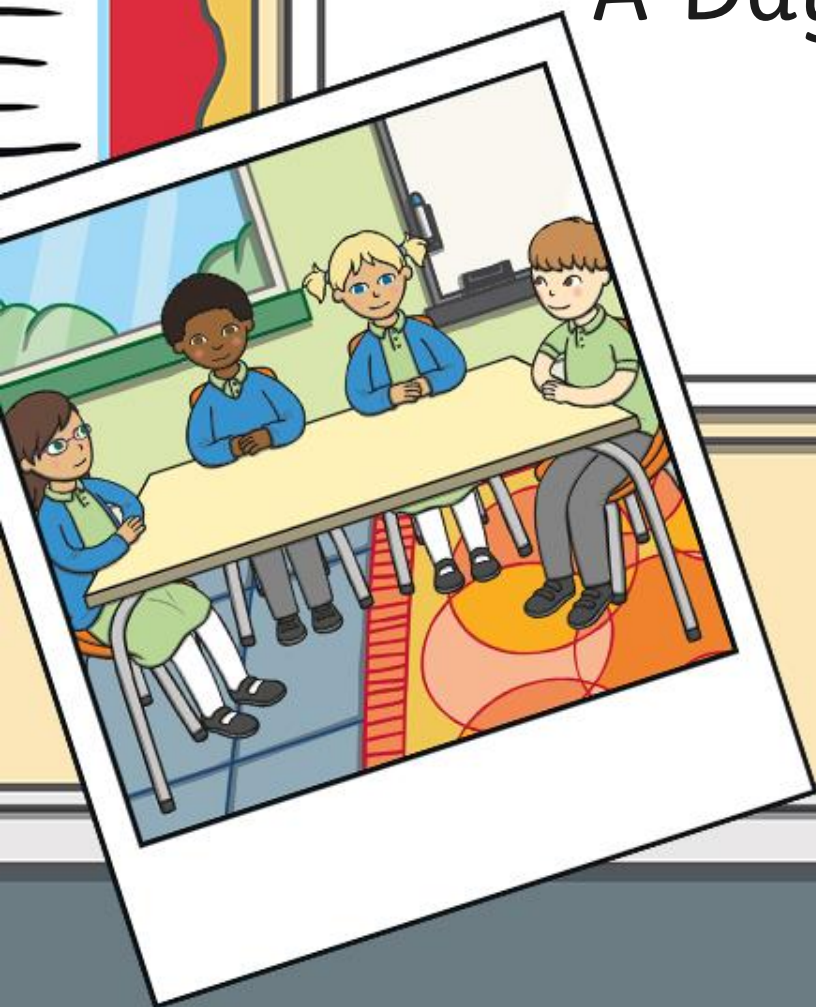


Starting School

When you come into the nursery, you will need to take off your coat and hang it on your peg. Each child in nursery has their own peg. You can put your PE bag on your peg too.





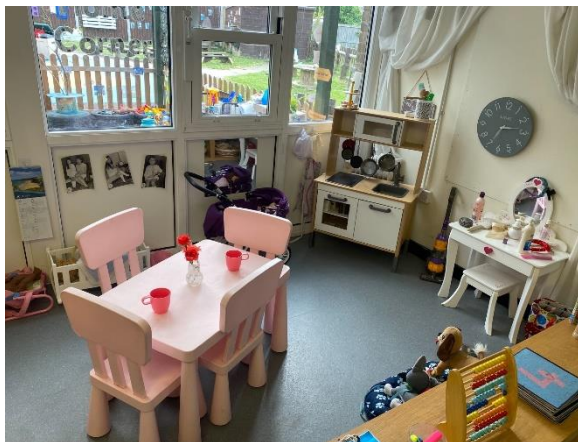
Once you have hung your coat up and put your book bag away, we sit down on the carpet for circle time.

Our next job is to do the register. We stop what we are doing and I will read out a list of all the children's name's in nursery to see who is in school today. When I say your name, you will say "good morning/ afternoon Mrs Webb" to let me know you are in school.

After we have done the register we have circle time! I will talk to you about the day and tell you all the wonderful things we will be doing. We talk about the weather and sing some songs.
