





Literacy Bingo Explained!

Hide an item behind your back. Describe what it is.
Can they guess what it is?
Take turns!

Create your own character or make a comic about yourself!

Pretend to be a newsreader and film a broadcast. What's happening in your house or the world today? Pick a film as a family and watch. Write what you enjoyed most and share your answers!

Play hangman using tricky words or spellings your child needs to practice! Take some time to write a letter or draw pictures to family and friends.

Wear a blindfold and listen carefully. Adults can use a range of items to make different sounds. Can you hear them? What are they? Write out rhyming words and then hide them round the room. Can your child find them and match them up again?

Make your own set of dominoes using spellings. Match the spellings together to play dominoes! Write spellings on the floor with chalk. Use a brush of some sort to scrub the word away. Don't forget to read it first! Write spellings inside a zip lock bag. Fill it with paint and let the children try to find the words hidden!

Use newspapers, magazines, etc. to cut out different aspects of places. Stick them together and make your own setting. Write about what happens there.

Draw a picture of your favourite place. Write why it is your favourite place and what you do/have done there!

Write down how you're feeling at the end of every day. Write what makes you feel good so you can look back and remember.

Write your own story and illustrate it. Share it with someone in your house! Write your spellings but use bubble writing.
